Age 17 - "I'd been in survival mode for so long that I didn't know anything different. I never had my own things and never was in a safe place. By the time I entered care, I was numb to living anymore. Like I was watching my life from outside my body.

The Hope Bag had simple things like clothes, shoes, deodorant, soap, socks, a blanket, and a journal in it. But it was these simple things that made me feel like someone was saying, 'You get to start fresh. You get another chance. You can continue. I have carried those bags through every placement so far, and it is the only thing that I have known to never be taken from me. It represents the beginning of my new life."
